## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF RECRUITING CASA VOLUNTEERS OF COLOR

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Diversity of the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges (NCJFCJ) recognizes and acknowledges a shortage of Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) volunteers of color; and

**WHEREAS**, the Committee on Diversity recognizes the need for continued utilization of CASA services, as well as continued and on-going cultural diversity training for CASA volunteers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, Judges should assist in the recruitment of CASA volunteers in general, and of CASA volunteers of color in particular, on the local level in their respective jurisdictions;

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED**, Judges should be instrumental in encouraging local CASA chapters to engage in frequent recruitment and cultural diversity training of its volunteers.
